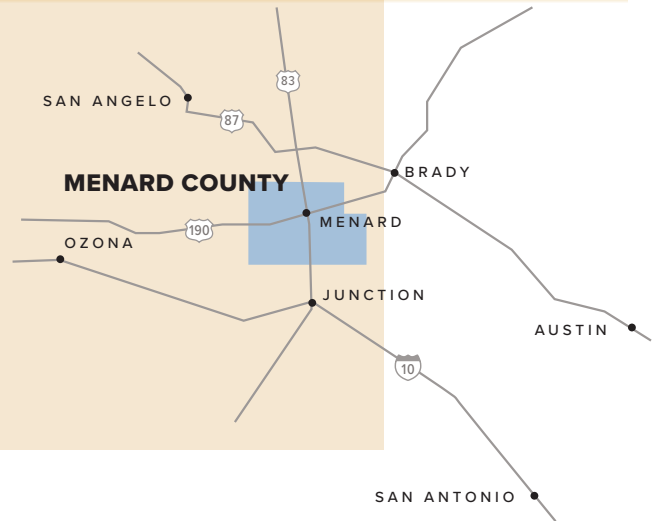


## MENARD COUNTY

### THE RURAL LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANTS ALLOWED MENARD COUNTY TO:

#### SHERIFF'S OFFICE

- Increase the sheriff's annual salary.
- Fill an open deputy position.
- Provide a wage increase to all jailers and deputies.
- Add two new patrol vehicles.

#### ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

- Hire a full-time chief legal assistant.

#### 452ND DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

- Hire two new full-time administrative positions.
- Give raises to three existing employees.
