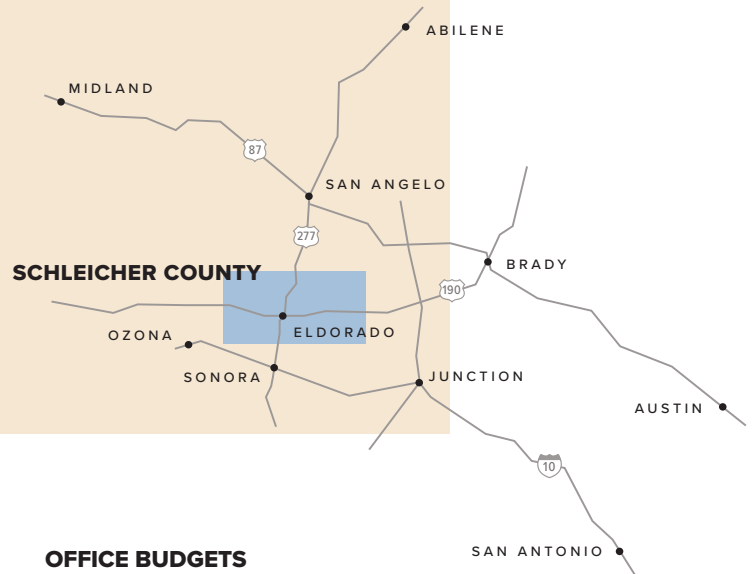


SCHLEICHER COUNTY

THE RURAL LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANTS ALLOWED SCHLEICHER COUNTY TO:

SHERIFF'S OFFICE

- Increase the sheriff's annual salary.
- Increase the salary for four full-time deputies and one part-time deputy.
- Hire an additional part-time deputy.
- Increase the salaries for six corrections officers.
- Hire two part-time corrections officers.
- Purchase equipment for the sheriff and deputies.

51ST AND 119TH DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICES

- Fill vacant positions within the office.
- Hire three legal assistants.
- Hire two victim assistants.
