

Notice of Arbitration Withdrawal

This form may only be used for property owners who are not participating in the online arbitration system. All other property owners and all agents must withdraw cases in the online arbitration system only.

GENERAL INFORMATION: A property owner who is not participating in the online arbitration system may use this form to withdraw a request for arbitration as allowed by Comptroller Rule 9.4208. **This form is for property owners who are not participating in the online arbitration system only. If a property owner or agent is participating in the online arbitration system, the arbitration must be withdrawn in the system.**

FILING INSTRUCTIONS: The property owner must complete this form then send the form to the Comptroller's office, appraisal district and arbitrator (if one has accepted the case).

The mailing address for the Comptroller's office is Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts, Property Tax Assistance Division, P.O. Box 13528, Austin, Texas 78711-3528 and the email address is ptad.arbitration@cpa.texas.gov. A directory with contact information for appraisal district offices can be found on the Comptroller's website.

FILING DEADLINES: If this notice is filed in writing with the Comptroller's office before an arbitrator has accepted the case, the Comptroller will refund the deposit less the Comptroller's \$50 administrative fee to the property owner. If this notice is filed after an arbitrator has accepted the case, the Comptroller's office will pay the Comptroller's \$50 administrative fee, the arbitrator's fee and refund the remainder, if any, to the property owner.
